Using Ho Tactics On Rich Millennial Men

You bring nothing to the table that he hasn't seen on his IG explore page. The simps online or the broke locals may label you special, but High Value Men pass on you because the stench of your basic bitch aroma is overpowering.

If you pay your own rent, don't brag as if you're a finesse queen! The world is filled with tricks, but have you gotten 20k without throwing pussy? If

you don't think you need this book, then explain to me right now what you could do on a date (with your clothes on) that will make a man want to invest in your ideas?

Pandemic or not, the Tactics in this book will always work because men who have it to trick will always trick. The question is, are you patient, disciplined, and savage enough to use the secrets I'm about to share on men around your age?

Social media changed the game for men with disposable income. Every type of woman is a direct message away, and all it takes for these men to get a reply is to have a page that shows off that he's paid or has a high follower count. Men without money *Ho Bait* the most, meaning they flash money or cars online in order to seduce shallow women. The game has evolved, and these men are prepared for your finesse attempts. Their game is to mind fuck you, sleep with you, and toss you to the side before you can put your plan in motion.

If you don't possess confidence and dick discipline, then don't try Ho Tactics on younger men! Wealthy millennials know they can get everything you have to offer for cheap. They don't trust you, they see through your basic attempts to use these tactics, and they dangle enough money to make you thirsty. This results in you being used before you have a chance to use them. **Let's get this straight, you're fucking a man with wealth, and all you can get out of it is dinner, petty cash, or cheap jewelry?**

You left money on the table because you were too afraid to follow my tactics or thought that you were smarter than this book and could do your own thing. In the end, the male hos with money are making you their marks, and it's time to reverse course.

This chapter is a crash course on positioning yourself as a one of one. Men spend money, chase, and hold onto women who can't be found elsewhere. Your job isn't to be like the random thots on social media with cosmetic appeal. Your job is to challenge him mentally and tease him sexually. I don't care if you meet men by DMing them online or in airport bars between flights. The power isn't in the introduction. The power is in what you do after that first connection that will make you stand out.

Fear Factor

Reading about Maria's Ho-Conquest, your adrenaline spiked, your mind raced, and you felt a form of indirect confidence. Your intuition tingled because you now know that **feminine power is God power. Everything that you want can be yours.** No man is above your charm. You are undeniable! That isn't an affirmation. That's a spoiler. The anticipation you have to go out and try Ho Tactics is so great that most of you don't even finish this book! So fast and so undisciplined! *"I read enough. I'm securing the bag this weekend."* ...or so you thought.

Flirting with men on dating apps is easy. Getting in the pockets of some lame who already likes you isn't finessing. Going after old sugar daddy type doesn't require confidence because you don't want them on a real level; thus, they don't intimidate you. Where you fuck up at is that you can't get anything from high value men? **What happens when men look good and talk even better?** You freeze up, like him more than he likes you, and allow him to mind fuck you like a typical Basical!

I've advised dozens of women who were great at Ho Tactics for a month when it's all a video game. Then they come across someone who's handsome, or an ex tries to come back into their lives, and they fail miserably. The reason it's so easy to get 3 thousand dollars from a guy you just met off Bumble is because

you're not emotionally invested enough to be scared of his rejection. The reason why you can't look your boyfriend in the eyes and tell him you'd like him to pay for your hair and nail appointments from now on is because you are emotionally invested and are terrified to hear "no" or "I'll see."

Ho Tactics and fear can't coexist! You claim you're not afraid of anything, then confess that you hate being told "no." Go deeper! Why do you hate "no" to the point where you would rather do things for yourself than ask? Because you're afraid of what that "no" means. If it's a new guy, that "no" means he isn't impressed enough by your looks to give you what you want. He sees you as "mid," and that hurts your ego. If it's someone you're already dealing with, his "no" means that this man doesn't love you enough to give you what you want even though you are willing to do the most for him. **Your ego makes you out to be so special, but when was the last time a man really treated you special outside of apology gifts, a birthday, or sex?** You don't get things just because, and that's a shame because so many women do!

Be honest, failing to get a man you put on a pedestal to give you something makes you feel like a loser. **All these ratchet rap chicks talk about how easy they get Chanel bags, and you can't even get a pair of headphones.** All these basic blonde girls with

their oversexualized podcasts talk about how they get flown to islands, and you can't even get reimbursed for an Uber. That. Shit. Hurts! I don't expect you to destroy your ego overnight, but I want you to realize this "I don't want to hear no" shit is a wall that's blocking you from pulling off these tactics.

Do you believe you're pretty enough to be spoiled? Do you think you're confident enough to seduce a man? I know what you're capable of, I know you are power—but if YOU don't believe, then anytime a younger man pops on your radar, you'll end up letting him get away with murder. Are you built to mindfuck men, or are you just a boy-crazy romantic who just wants male attention? You can read this book every month, you can become a pro at doing your makeup, you could even go get your body done. None of that matters if you're mentally soft when it comes to men. Do you know what men think of you while they're smiling in your face, liking your pictures, and making false promises? *"She can read all the dating advice, but in the end, she's still a ditz with daddy issues. She can go get a BBL, but in the end, she's still an insecure little girl who no one paid attention to. Watch how easy I run through this dumb bitch."* It's time to prove these men wrong!

Affirmation: No man is bigger, smarter, or better than me. There is no way he can reject me because I am secure in my power. There is no way he can make me chase him because I am confident in my ability to manifest someone better.

Declaration: From this day forward, fear will not exist when I am dating. I will take comfort in the mission and gain strength in the knowledge that I Am That Bitch.

Trust Factor

I advised a woman in Chicago who was looking to get money to start her cosmetic business. She set her intentions on 50k in three months to launch by the summer. She was dating two guys, a wealthy Nigerian man and a blue-collar maintenance worker who owed his own window cleaning business. Both men were in their late 20s and a bit flashy, which is how they caught her attention on Instagram. The Nigerian guy would take her out to random parties and introduce Ms. Chicago to all of his friends, then they would chill at his house. Blue Collar would take her out on actual dates, and they would talk in the car for hours afterward. She told me that she liked Blue Collar the most but wanted to focus on the Nigerian as he was worth millions, spent freely on bottle service, and would most likely provide her 50K faster.

I advised her to go after Blue Collar, as he was more emotionally invested. I've been doing this for years, and I personally know Korean men, Indian men, and many African men who use money to get easy sex, they flaunt their wealth, you can google their family and their net worth, and it's all a game because they don't have to spend on that woman, she just wants to be a part of that lifestyle.

Ms. Chicago disagreed with me and doubled her efforts on The Nigerian, trying to create a fast bond. She thought her sloppy version of Ho Tactics was working. Finally, she tested The Nigerian by telling him that her rent was due, and she had spent her paycheck helping her mother out a week earlier. The Nigerian gave her the rent money, which was less than 2k, nothing to a man like him. However, when she came over to get the money, he was more aggressive than usual. She told him she wasn't ready for sex, and he did what most men do, he explained, "We don't have to go all the way."

She wrote upset that what was supposed to be a quick money test ended with her giving the Nigerian head. He even left extra money for her afterward, basically treating her like a prostitute. By the time Ms. Chicago told him about her business idea, he had shot it down as a bad investment but offered to give her some business advice when they met up again.

That advice cost as The Nigerian basically lured her over, pressured for sex again, and this time they went all the way. For the next month, Ms. Chicago basically became a sex toy that got a few thousand here and there. She could pay her rent, but at what cost?

My initial advice to Ms. Chicago when she first emailed me her prospects were to focus on Blue Collar as clearly, they were building a deeper bond. In her mind, if a man is blowing 10-15k on liquor, strip clubs, etc... he's an easy mark. She failed to realize that women like Ms. Chicago are a dime a dozen in the Nigerian's circle. She did nothing to distinguish herself as a real option. He met her on IG because he was attracted to her looks, and he knew that she would be attracted to the pictures of his cars and lavish lifestyle. The Nigerian was "Ho baiting," and Ms. Chicago didn't realize that the hunter had become the hunted until it was too late.

That blue-collar business owner valued her enough to take her on official dates, not this "hey come hang out with my crew and pop bottles" bullshit. He wasn't in a race to take her back to his place; instead, he kept the conversation going in the car. He was primed to trust Ms. Chicago enough for her to work her tactics. However, the thirst for fast money got in the way.

I received a flood of emails from women I once advised during the pandemic, but none proved my point better than Ms. Chicago's last update. She informed me that although she ghosted that blue-collar guy, she continued to stalk his movies on social media. Last year, blue-collar had a massive wedding with "this bitch who doesn't even look half as good as me," as she put it.

Ms. Chicago fumbled the bag with a man who had a lot more money than she thought and who would have invested in her business. This is what happens when you get impatient and choose flashiness over connection! You always want a trick to like you more than you like him. A man who has a million dollars in the bank but doesn't trust you will never spoil you as hard as a man with 200k in the bank and thinks you're special. The net worth means nothing. It's about how much you can net based on the worth he sees in you!

"He thinks I'm pretty and wants to fuck me, so why not focus on the guy with the most money," Earth to Basica! Trust is everything when dealing with younger men! Those with extreme wealth are the least trusting. If a man managed to make a fortune before he turned 40, then that means he's intelligent, talented, or really good at picking lottery numbers. Let's assume that he's relatively smart, then his lust alone won't make him trust you enough to do more

than small tricks. He'll spend to fuck, as in pay to play, but he's too up on *Ho Game* to blindly trust you and label you the wifey type.

In the past, women could manipulate men with money relatively easily because the idea of "she's smarter than me" was the male's Achilles heel. Look at the famous Hos throughout history. The men they made their fortune or fame off didn't see it coming because of their own egos. *"She wouldn't use me for money, she's not that smart... she wouldn't have a baby with me to get the child support, she's not that savvy... she wouldn't marry me after all these years just to divorce me, she's not that forward-thinking."* Long before the age of Housewife reality shows and Instagram influencers, there were women who knew how to get to the bag, drain a man, and move on with their lives.

Men aren't more intelligent now; they're just more aware. Women snitch on themselves by posting about their sugar daddies. The current ladies of hip hop talk about scamming men out of money excessively to the point where finessing is a mainstream concept. **What happens when secrets get out? It fucks up your ability to move in silence!**

We live in the information age where men can educate themselves on how others have been played and adjust. There are forums, message boards, books, and YouTube videos about how to spot gold diggers. The idea of "watch out" has even trickled down to

broke men whose only assets are sneakers and Xbox games. These men would rather meet up for coffee dates because they don't trust your intentions. Think about that, "ho fear" is so great that even broke men are careful. So, imagine how distrusting a man with real money has become in the past 5 years?

Coach Deion Sanders invited my friend, the infamous and brilliant Brittany Renner¹, to speak with the players of Jackson State about how they will be targeted by women if they happen to make it to the NFL. After Brittany's speech, Coach Sanders remarked, "If I had been sitting in that room at Florida State and I had her come and lay it out like she laid it out... I would have had that I would be at least \$20 million richer."

Recognize that men are now on high alert and will continue to be skeptical about you. The only way to counteract suspicion is to earn trust. Lazy effort will never lead to trust. "Babe, can you help me out with a bill," after two dates is transparent. "I don't understand why we have to split the bills when you make more," in a relationship where you haven't seemed concerned about money will make your boyfriend or husband think you're up to something sneaky; maybe trying to save money so you can get

your own place and leave him. The point is, you can't just put in half of the work, hold your hand out, and expect a man to give it to you.

Why do men with money spend on strippers, escorts, or take on mistresses? **There is no trust needed in transactional relationships!** That man paying for a lap dance and trying to negotiate an "after the club" price knows that dancer is working him. That British man in New York for a week will happily call up an escort to have dinner with him before he tries his luck on Tinder. He's paying for a woman who understands what "company" means, not trying to solicit a connection with someone who has ulterior motives. Married men, especially as they get up there in age, would rather buy a condo for a woman who he knows will keep her mouth shut and be at his beck and call rather than take his chances sneaking around with someone who would try to blackmail him or want him to leave his wife for her.

Transactions don't require trust, it's clinical, and the rules are understood. At the same time, the man will always be in control of these situations. You're getting hundreds from someone with millions. You're getting a house that he can take back. You're getting negotiated down to what he thinks you're worth because, in his mind, you're beneath him, a sex slave. Ho Tactics, where you actually get a man to trust and need, you will always net more money and

a better lifestyle than a transactional relationship, as you, the woman, set the rules. However, as I just laid out, fear and trust are the locks that must be removed to gain access to his mind. **How do you gain trust without spending years “faking” a relationship?**
